Apply for Fuel Assistance through November 14

The Norfolk Department of Human Services is accepting applications for the Fuel Assistance Program through Monday, November 14. Fuel Assistance is available to residents who are responsible for heating expenses and whose monthly gross incomes meet eligibility guidelines.

Fuel Assistance can be used to help pay for an electric or gas bill to operate heating equipment, to cover the cost of an electric or gas bill deposit or assist with the purchase of oil, kerosene or propane used to heat a household.

To qualify, the maximum monthly income for a one-person household is \$1,180. For a family of four, the maximum is \$2,422.
