Glenroe Drainage Improvement Project Nears Completion - The major work of the Glenroe Drainage Improvement Project has been completed with the exception of the addition of guardrails and landscaping. The purpose of this project was to fill a 7 foot deep hole that was in the vacant city right-of-way, northeast of the intersection of Glenroe Avenue and North Shore Road. The underlying septic sewer pipes and water utility pipes in the immediate vicinity of the depression were also replaced and there was no disruption of service to nearby residents. This \$300,000 project was funded from City of Norfolk CIP funding.

Guardrails will be installed during the first week of November to keep vehicular traffic off of the vacant area. Landscaping will also be installed in the near future.
