Norfolk to Host another Illegal Sign Removal Training Program for Citizens

NORFOLK – In an effort to keep Norfolk’s right-of-way clean, the Department of Public Works will host another illegal sign removal training program. The program will be held on Thursday, October 12th, from 1 p.m. until 2 p.m. at the Ernie Morgan Action Center located at 3500-A Granby Street, Norfolk, VA 23504. The center is near the Norfolk Zoo complex.

The training is open to all residents of Norfolk and will serve as a means to educate residents on what is the right-of-way, what signs should be removed, how to remove the signs, and where to take signs after removal. At the end of the training program, residents will receive a wallet size “illegal sign removal certification” card.
