**STREET RESURFACING SCHEDULED FOR LITTLE CREEK
ROAD AND HAMPTON BOULEVARD**

Norfolk, VA-The Department of Public Works will begin resurfacing work on two major arterials later this month. On October 24, contractors will begin milling Little Creek Road between Meadow Creek Road and Becket Street. There will be alternating lane closures in place to accommodate traffic and manage the work. Drivers will experience some delays in the area. The intersection of Little Creek Road and Chesapeake Boulevard will be resurfaced at a later date, after the utility work is completed next spring.

Beginning October 30, resurfacing work will begin on Hampton Boulevard between 21st Street and 38th Street. The Contractor is scheduled to work from 7:00am to 3:00pm, but for the morning rush-hour commute, the paving operation will be limited to work in the southbound lanes. For both projects, contractors have been instructed to lay down temporary striping of the milled surface prior to reopening lanes to traffic.
