***October 27<sup>th</sup> New Road Closures***

**Norfolk, VA-** The City of Norfolk has the following new road closures to report.

Through November 4<sup>th</sup>, Bute Street will be closed between Granby Street and Boush Street.

Through November 10<sup>th</sup>, the northbound lane in the 400 block of Saint Pauls Boulevard will be closed. Also, through November 10<sup>th</sup>, commuters are asked to watch for a lane shift on Colley Avenue between Brambleton Avenue and Southampton Boulevard due to the installation of “chicken trax” crossing.

Through November 29<sup>th</sup>, the northbound right lane on Monticello Avenue will be closed in front of MacArthur Mall.

Beginning October 30, resurfacing work will begin on Hampton Boulevard from 21<sup>st</sup> Street to 38<sup>th</sup> Street. The Contractor is scheduled to work from 7:00am to 3:00pm, but in the morning, the paving work will only take place in the southbound lanes.
