***November 3<sup>rd</sup> New Road Closures***

**Norfolk, VA-** The City of Norfolk has the following new road closures to report in downtown Norfolk:

Atlantic Street - through November 20<sup>th</sup>, the southbound curb lane on Atlantic Street between Main Street and Waterside Drive will be closed for installation of air conditioning unit.

Granby Street - through November 14<sup>th</sup>, the northbound curb lane of Granby Street between East Plume Street and East City Hall Avenue will be closed to through traffic. Additionally, through November 10<sup>th</sup>, Granby Street will be closed between Brambleton Avenue and Bute Street due to utility work.

Monticello Avenue - through November 7<sup>th</sup>, watch for closure of the southbound inside lane of Monticello Avenue between Tazewell Street and City Hall Avenue due to utility work.

Plume Street – through November 14<sup>th</sup>, watch for closure of the westbound curb lane of East Plume Street between Granby Street and Atlantic Street.

Additionally, there will be alternating lane closures on the following major roads throughout the city:

Campostella Road – through November 30<sup>th</sup> the following sections of Campostella Road will be closed:

- the outside southbound lane on Campostella Road between the Campostella Bridge and Filmore Street due to utility work.
- the southbound lane on Campostella Road between Filmore Street and Arlington Avenue for purpose of Cathodic Protection.

- the southbound lane on Campostella Road between Arlington Avenue and Stow Street
- the inside southbound lane on Campostella Road at the northwest corner of Springfield Avenue.

Lafayette Boulevard – through November 9<sup>th</sup>, flaggers will direct traffic in the southbound lane of Lafayette Boulevard between Bapaume Avenue and Dunkirk Avenue.

Virginia Beach Boulevard – through November 21<sup>st</sup>, there will be alternating lane closures on East Virginia Beach Boulevard between May Avenue and Park Avenue due to concrete road repairs.
