NOR'EASTER UPDATE- 3PM

Norfolk, VA- The city of Norfolk has closed the flood gates at Pedestrian Avenue and Brook Avenue and the gates will remain closed until Friday. As of this hour, the remaining 3 flood gates are open and crews will be on stand by tonight to close them if needed.

Regular garbage that was *not* collected today as a result of the storm will be picked up on Saturday. Meanwhile, regular garbage and recycled waste will be collected on Thanksgiving, and the day after, Friday, November 24 as scheduled.

Flood waters have receded in most areas of the city. At this hour Shore Drive Bridge, east of Little Creek Road still have partial lane closures due to downed power lines.

Public Works crews will continue to monitor roads throughout the city and make adjustments as necessary as high tide approaches this evening.
