Waste Management to Follow Normal Pick-up Schedule for Veterans Day Holiday

Norfolk, VA - Friday, November 10th is a Federal holiday and the City administrative offices will be closed. In the City of Norfolk, Friday is a regular trash collection day, therefore trash and recyclables will still be picked up as scheduled.

If you have additional bags and large bulky items that will not fit into the trash container, you must request a special collection. For residents whose regular trash collection day is on Veterans Day, the request must be called in by 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 9th. Please contact the Department of Public Works' Division of Waste Management at 441-5813 or visit the website at www.norfolk.gov/publicworks/waste.asp to request a bulk pickup.

Please remember that the blue recycling carts will only accommodate recyclable materials, which are listed on top of the cart's lid. Trash containers and your 90-gallon blue recycling cart must be placed on the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day before collection and no later than 7:00 a.m. the morning of the collection day. If you are traveling for the holiday and forget to put out your container, please wait until your next scheduled collection day.
