Portions of W. Ocean View Avenue to Close for Road Repairs

Work Scheduled to Begin as Early as Wednesday, July 29

Norfolk, Va.—Starting as early as Wednesday, July 29, portions of W. Ocean View Avenue will close to allow crews to begin work on the first phase of a roadway repair project.

During the work, the westbound side of W. Ocean View will be completely closed to through traffic between 7th View Street and 15th View Street, with two-way traffic shifting to the east side of Ocean View Avenue. Neighborhood access will be maintained at all times.

The work is expected to be completed within 60 days, weather conditions permitting. Traffic will then be reversed for the second phase, also anticipated to be completed within 60 days.

The City of Norfolk reminds motorists that the downtown area is open for business throughout all construction projects. Parking is available in over 9,000 spaces in downtown facilities after 6 p.m. on weekdays and on weekends, and is easily accessible via primary streets outside the construction zones.
