

## 2009-2010 WASTE MANAGEMENT HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Norfolk- A number of legal holidays falls on a Monday, and since refuse collectors do not pick up trash in the city of Norfolk on Mondays there is no change in service. Bulk pick-up requests however, must be called in or emailed in by 3:00 p.m. on the Friday before the holiday.

When holidays fall during the week, trash and recyclables will still be collected as scheduled. The only exception is Christmas Day.

Collection of blue recycling carts will follow the same schedule as waste collection. Be sure to place your 90-gallon blue recycling cart at the curb filled with recyclable materials that are listed on top of the cart lids.

Below is a list of observed legal holidays in 2010:

New Year's Day – Friday, January 1

Martin Luther King, Jr. Day – Monday, January 18

Presidents' Day – Monday, February 15

Memorial Day – Monday, May 31

Independence Day – Monday, July 5

Labor Day – Monday, September 6

Veterans' Day – Thursday, November 11

Thanksgiving Day – Thursday, November 26

Christmas Day – Saturday, December 25

Please remember that all trash containers and the 90-gallon blue recycling cart can be placed at the curb after 5:00 p.m. the day before collection and no later than 7:00 a.m. the morning of collection.
