## Norfolk Commissioner of the Revenue Relocates Office for Real Estate Tax Relief for Disabled or Senior Citizens

**June 30, 2008** - Norfolk's Commissioner of the Revenue, Sharon M. McDonald, announced the relocation of her Real Estate Tax Relief Office from 21<sup>st</sup> St. to the first floor of the City Hall Building.

The move was necessary because of the construction of the new Ghent Station. The Norfolk Skills Center, where the Tax Relief Office was located, is being prepared for demolition.

Tax Relief customers are encouraged to call the Commissioner's office for directions to City Hall.

The Real Estate Tax Relief for Disabled or Senior Citizens offers to help reduce or eliminate the real estate taxes for qualifying disabled or senior citizen homeowners. The exemption is granted on an annual basis. Over 4,200 households were offered real estate tax relief in 2007.
