The TAG-OUT Graffiti Abatement Program works directly with concerned residents, business-owners and community based agencies to identify, report, and remove graffiti from public and private spaces in Norfolk.

Volunteer opportunities include:

- **Adopting-A-Spot to keep graffiti-free for 6 months**
- **Requesting a TAG-OUT clean-up event for your group**
- **Participating in a TAG-OUT clean-up event**
