The service will be provided on a walk-in first come, first served basis. The following documentation is required:

- Copies of all W-2, 1098 and 1099 forms
- Social Security or Individual Tax Identification Number
- Provider's address and Tax Identification Number for Child/Dependent Care Credit
- Form 8332 or copy of divorce decree for non-custodial parent claiming child
- Banking Information (check or savings account) for direct deposit
- Amounts and dates of other tax payments
- Amounts of other income
