REAL ESTATE TAX RELIEF

Commissioner of Revenue Sharon McDonald announced today that four satellite offices will be established to distribute information on Real Estate Tax Relief for senior citizens.

In order to be eligible, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Must be 65 years of age or totally and permanently disabled
- Must live on the property to be exempted
- Combined income of those who live in the dwelling cannot exceed \$67,000
- Net worth of applicant, not including home, cannot exceed \$350,000
