Olde Huntersville Water & Sewer Replacement, Phases 3 and 5

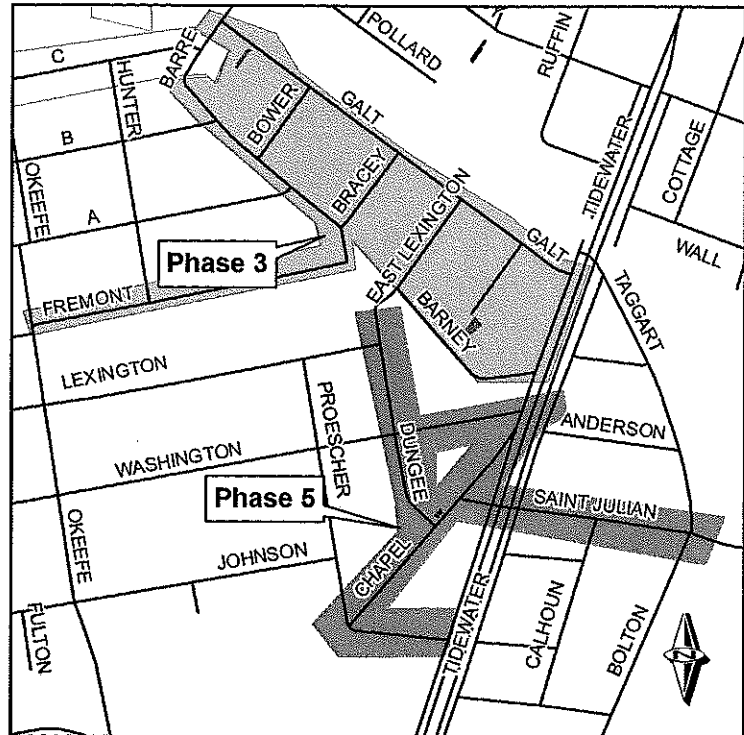
The City continues to make progress on the \$4 million water and sewer improvements currently underway in the Olde Huntersville Neighborhood.

Phase 3 Construction Update:

New water and sewer lines have been installed and undergoing final inspection before they are put in service. All Phase 3 construction, including street paving and curb and gutter restoration, will be finished by mid-November.

Phase 5 Construction Update:


The installation of new water mains is continuing along Chapel and Goochland Streets between Washington Avenue and Tidewater Drive, as well as along Saint Julian Ave between Bolton Street and Tidewater Drive. The construction



of new sanitary sewer lines will follow along Saint Julian Avenue. During this construction, northbound and southbound traffic along Tidewater Drive will be temporary detoured. All Phase 5 construction is expected to be complete by the end of Spring 2012.
