Dear Valued Customer,

During last week's nor'easter, the sanitary sewer pipe that runs under Studeley Avenue near Bolling Avenue collapsed. An emergency pump was installed to bypass the collapsed section of pipe. We have hired a contractor to replace the broken pipe as soon as possible. Tomorrow, Tidewater Utilities will begin replacing approximately 365 feet of sewer pipe from manhole to manhole. The work zone is shown in the hatched area on the map to the right and will take approximately 5 weeks to complete.

While construction is underway, Studeley Avenue will be closed to through traffic between Bolling and Magnolia Avenues. Access to driveways will be maintained and through traffic will be detoured via Powhatan Avenue.



The City and our contractor will do our best to minimize the unavoidable disruptions associated with the construction.
