#### **REGULAR AGENDA**

- R-1 An Ordinance Appropriating Funds for Operation of the City for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2020 and Ending June 30, 2021, Appropriating U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Entitlement Grants, Appropriating Annual Reoccurring Grants, Increasing Certain Fees, and Regulating the Payment of Money from the City Treasury.

- R-6 An Ordinance approving the July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 budget for the Norfolk Law Library, authorizing the City Treasurer to make disbursements and appropriating and authorizing the expenditure of up to \$232,900.00 by the Norfolk Law Library from various sources including monies assessed and collected by the city as part of costs in civil court actions in accordance with the approved budget and the October 1, 1987 agreement among the City, the Norfolk Law Library and the Norfolk and Portsmouth Bar Association.
- R-7 An Ordinance to Authorize Encroachments for the Temporary Installation of Outdoor Dining Areas for Existing Restaurants in the public right-of-way in the Downtown, Traditional and Coastal Character Districts in Accordance with Defined Standards and to Authorize the City Manager to Approve Such Temporary Encroachments for Existing Restaurants in the Suburban Character District or in Exception to the Defined Standards as Needed.
