

III. **Description:**

This agenda item is an ordinance to accept a grant of \$20,000 from the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental services for the Norfolk Community Services Board ("NCSB") to implement the Virginia Opioid Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Program to fill in the gap that current Strategic Prevention grant does not cover and for building a coalition for reduction of opioid death.

IV. **Analysis**

This \$20,000 is a new grant award in addition to the current funding of \$31,000. The total for the grant period (May 1, 2018 to April 30, 2019) is \$51,000. This is the second year NCSB has received the grant to implement the Virginia Opioid Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Program.

### ORDINANCE No.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD OF \$20,000 FROM THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES FOR THE NORFOLK COMMUNITY SERVICES BOARD TO IMPLEMENT THE VIRGINIA OPIOID PREVENTION, TREATMENT AND RECOVERY PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF THE FUNDS IF AND WHEN RECEIVED.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norfolk:

Section 1:- That a grant of \$20,000 from the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services for the Norfolk Community Services Board to implement the Virginia Opioid Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Program to fill in the gap that the current Strategic Prevention grant does not cover and to build a coalition for reduction of opioid deaths.

Section 2:- That \$20,000 in grant funds are hereby appropriated and authorized for expenditure for FY2019, if and when made available from the Department of Behavioral Health and Development Services.

Section 3:- That this ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption.
