**ORDINANCE No.**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REORDAIN SECTION 16-58 OF THE NORFOLK CITY CODE, 1979, AS AMENDED, **SO AS TO** CONFORM WITH SECTION 11 OF THE NORFOLK CITY CHARTER.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norfolk:

Section 1:- That section 16-58 of the Norfolk City Code, 1979, regarding the election and term of the City Auditor, is hereby amended and reordained its entirety so as to read as follows:

**Sec. 16-58. - Election; term.**

The city council shall appoint a city auditor, who shall be appointed for an indefinite period and serve at the will of the city council.

Section 2:- That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its date of adoption.
