III. **Description:**

This agenda item is an ordinance to accept a grant of \$92,196 from the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services for Norfolk Community Services Board ("NCSB") to implement the Virginia Opioid Prevention, Treatment and Recovery ("VA OPT-R") Program. ### ORDINANCE No.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING, APPROPRIATING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF A GRANT AWARD OF \$92,196 FROM THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES FOR THE NORFOLK COMMUNITY SERVICES BOARD TO CONTINUE TO IMPLEMENT THE VIRGINIA OPIOID PREVENTION, TREATMENT AND RECOVERY PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH A DIAGNOSIS OF OPIOID USE DISORDER WHO DO NOT HAVE FINANCIAL RESOURCES TO ACCESS MEDICALLY ASSISTED TREATMENT.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norfolk:

Section 1:- That a grant of \$92,196<sup>00</sup> is hereby accepted from the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services for the Norfolk Community Services Board to continue to implement the Virginia Opioid Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Program for individuals with a diagnosis of Opioid Use Disorder who do not have financial resources to access medically assisted treatment.

Section 2:- That \$92,126<sup>00</sup> in grant funds are hereby appropriated and authorized for expenditure for FY2019, if and when made available from the Department of Behavioral Health and Development Services.

Section 3:- That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its adoption.
