





ORDINANCE No.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING, APPROPRIATING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF A \$50,000 STATE OPIOID RESPONSE (SOR) GRANT AWARD FROM THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES FOR THE NORFOLK COMMUNITY SERVICES BOARD TO IMPLEMENT EFFECTIVE RESEARCH BASED PREVENTION STRATEGIES TO ADDRESS OPIOID MISUSE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norfolk:

Section 1:- That a \$50,000 State Opioid Response Grant from the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services for the Norfolk Community Services Board to implement effective research based prevention strategies to address opioid misuse is hereby accepted.

Section 2:- That \$50,000 in grant funds are hereby appropriated and authorized for expenditure for FY2019, if and when made available from the Department of Behavioral Health and Development Services.

Section 3:- That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its adoption.
