



Westminster Avenue Reconstruction (UPC 117116)

Location

The project begins approximately 500 feet east of the intersection of Ballentine Ave & Westminster Ave, and then running east ending for approximately 2,400 feet until reaching the railroad tracks.

Project Benefits

This project will create updated roads with new pavement for smoother travel. New sidewalks and ADA ramps will be included to improve pedestrian access.

The project will also address ongoing flooding along Westminster Avenue.

Scope of Work

Reconstruction work will take place on Westminster Avenue, beginning from Riviera Street and continuing all the way to the railroad tracks. The current 2-lane road will remain unchanged, but the project will eliminate inferior soils and construct new roads with an improved pavement section.

- Construction Start: Spring 2026
- Project Completion: Fall 2027

Project Funding

Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Revenue Sharing (RS) program.

VDOT Funding: \$1,733,511

City Funding: \$156,489

Construction Impacts

- Lane closures and sidewalk closures will be required; at least one lane in each direction will be open at all times.
- Trees removal will be required; approximately 52 trees will be removed. Replanting will take place.
