Application for Real Estate Tax Relief for The Surviving Spouse of a Member of The Armed Forces of The United States Who Died in The Line of Duty

REQUIREMENTS

- The United States Department of Defense must have determined the United States Armed Forces Member died in the line of duty, where such death was not the result of criminal conduct.
- The real property must be owned and occupied as the surviving spouses principal place of residence.
- The surviving spouse may not be remarried.

REQUESTED DOCUMENTS

- Documentation of the Line of Duty determination from the U.S. Department of Defense
- DD Form 1300
- Marriage Certificate
- Current VA Driver's License or VA Identification (ID) card with the address matching the application address.
- Current Dominion VA Power Bill with an address matching the application address.
