








In the corridor map above, on which side of Lafayette Blvd./E 26th St. do you live?

When driving into your neighborhood, from which main road do you typically turn?



When leaving your neighborhood, onto which main road do you typically turn?





Within the study area between Leo Street and Tidewater Drive shown in red above, at which intersection do you **most frequently turn?**














