About the Project

The City of Norfolk is leading a planning study to **reconnect neighborhoods and destinations around I-264, Downtown Norfolk, Harbor Park, Kindred Development, and Norfolk State University.**

For decades, the interstate has made it harder for people to move easily between homes, schools, jobs, and the waterfront. This effort will explore ways to bring those connections back or create new connections – creating safer, more convenient travel for everyone, no matter how they get around.

Purpose and Goals

- **Reconnect neighborhoods and destinations.** Reimagine connections between Downtown, Harbor Park, NSU, and nearby communities once divided by I-264.
- **Create safer, easier, more multimodal travel for all.** Design streets, sidewalks, and transit connections that are accessible and comfortable for people of all ages and abilities.
- **Expand access and opportunity.** Strengthen everyday connections to jobs, schools, parks, transit, and community spaces.
- **Work together.** Partner with residents, students, and businesses to shape improvements that reflect community priorities.


RECONNECTING COMMUNITIES PROGRAM

ESTABLISHED: 2021 *Bipartisan Infrastructure Law*

GRANT AMOUNT: \$1.6 Million (FY 2022)

STUDY AREA: I-264 around Downtown Norfolk, Harbor Park, Kindred Development, and Norfolk State University

FOCUS: Safe, easy, multimodal connections for people walking, biking, riding, rolling, or driving
