- iv. As of June 30, 2025, Total Plan Actuarial Liability (AL) is \$1.568 billion and the Actuarial Value of Assets (AVA) is \$1.377 billion for an Actuarial Funded Ratio (AVA/AL) of 88%, with a Market Funded Ratio of 91%. Using the Market Value of Assets (MVA), the Market Funded Ratio (MVA/AL) was approximately 95% in August 2025 and 97% in September 2025
- v. The Plan achieved an 11.1% return over the trailing twelve-month period, exceeding the assumed rate of return of 6.75%
- vi. According to the Peer Review (page 44 of the Meketa Investment Committee Meeting Materials), our year-to-date performance placed us in the top quartile—outperforming 98% of our peers
- vii. One-year returns were 14%. Comparatively, the trailing 10-year performance, which previously ranked in the 57th percentile, has improved significantly to the 14th percentile
