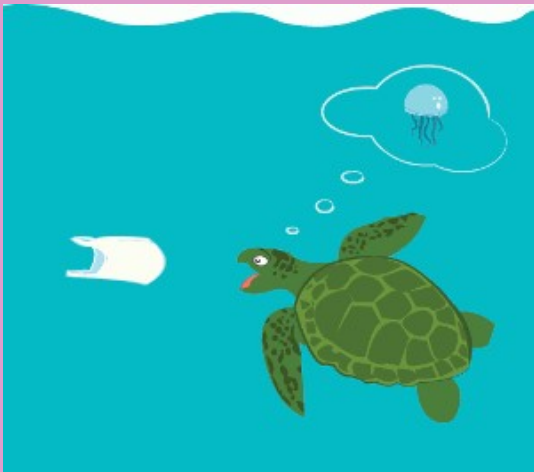

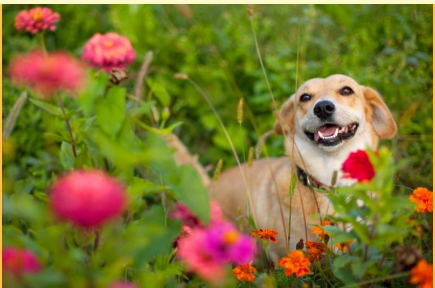
Is that a jelly fish?
