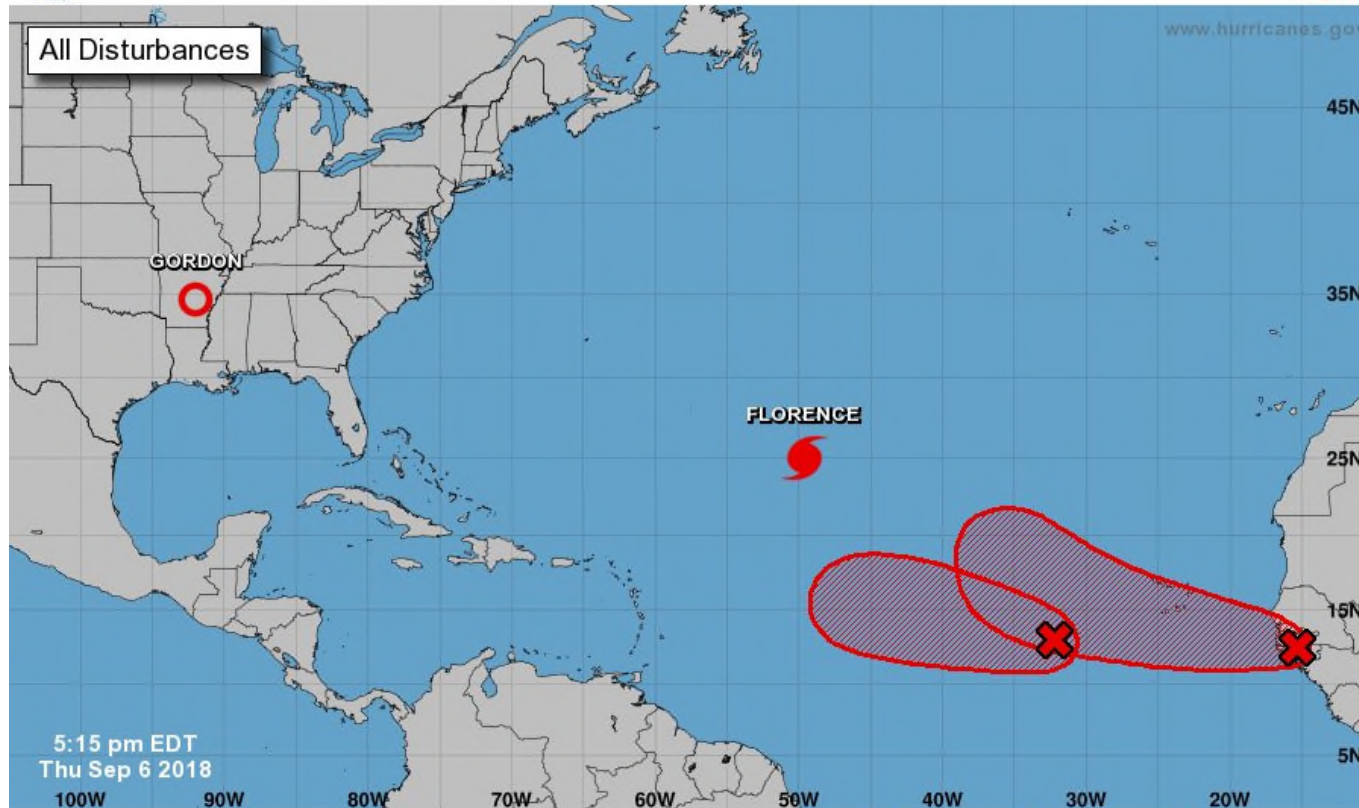

Five-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook
National Hurricane Center Miami, Florida



Current Disturbances and Five-Day Cyclone Formation Chance: < 40% 40-60% > 60%
Tropical or Sub-Tropical Cyclone: Depression Storm Hurricane
 Post-Tropical Cyclone or Remnants

*Note: Any specific predictions beyond the NHC 5 day forecast continue to be speculation
Where EYE of the storm might be 2/3 of the time.*

When: Mid- to Late Next Week

Readiness Condition 4

H-144 to 96 hours (D-6 to D-4 days)


- Continue monitoring storm
- Consider incident budget code
- Alert staff; Update PeopleSoft
 - Identify Dept. POC's
- Review plans; inspect equipment; fuel
- Prepare EOC for activation
- Communicate w/ Team Norfolk Partners
- Ensure availability of shelters, busses & drivers
 - Request Verizon equipment for wifi
- **Consider NOW resource needs**

Readiness Condition 3

*4 Days Out (H-96 hours) **Monday?***

- Local declaration (120 hours out)
- Set Operational Periods
- Conduct Team Norfolk Briefing Calls
- Partial EOC activation; JIC activation discussion
- Consider potential cancellation of special events
- Shelter teams placed on Stand-By
- Strategize parking safe-havens (City garages, etc.)

Team Norfolk Plans

The Code of Virginia, §44-146.19, requires each local jurisdiction and inter-jurisdictional agencies to prepare and keep current a local emergency operations plan. Every four years, each local agency will conduct a comprehensive review and revision of its emergency operations plan to ensure that the plan remains current. The following documents make up much of the Team Norfolk Emergency Operations and Resilience Framework. Not posted are documents of a sensitive nature such as Section II - Department-Specific Emergency Action Plans, Section V - Functional and Supporting Annexes and Section VI - the City's Continuity of Operations / Continuity of Government Plan.

It is important to note, while the following documents satisfy legal requirements, the framework is a collective work and reference to all Team Norfolk partners. In other words, these are your plans as well. As such, please review and challenge these plans! While the documents are updated throughout the year and certainly after any incident, only by having conversations about realistic expectations throughout the community will they be most effective.
