The project upgrades and repairs will improve the collection, movement, and discharge of stormwater runoff. Rehabilitation of the pump station will help to minimize damage to electrical components during major storm events.

- Extend underpass inlets
- Upgrade pumps

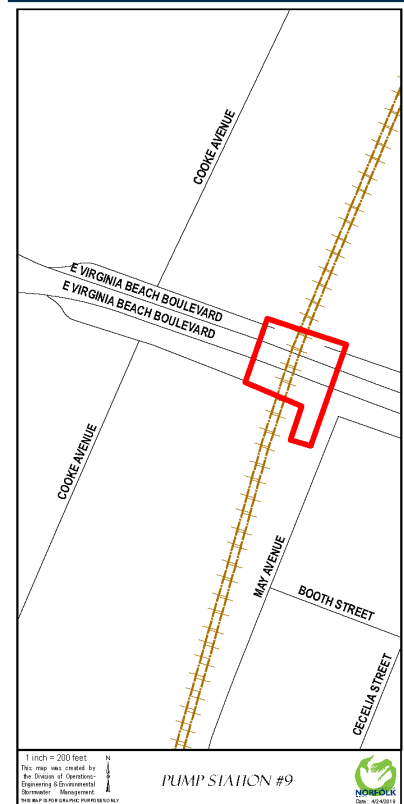
