PROJECT INFORMATION

The easement located at the newly acquired ADP office building, was formerly owned by the City of Norfolk. This easement, which connected the public to the Omni Hotel complex at Waterside, by way of a pedestrian bridge, will be demolished by City contractors.

As part of the demolition and removal process, the City will replace the already closed off pedestrian entry with windows and façade to match the adjacent windows.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Demolish and remove pedestrian bridge. **(Complete)**
- Install matching storefront window panel to match existing finishes.
