This rehabilitation project will improve the condition of the USS Wisconsin Basin Pedestrian Bridge by replacing deteriorating supporting wood structure, corroded electrical piping and installing composite decking material.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

- Replace supporting wood structure and decking, rusted hardware and attachments.
- Install a new composite deck.
- Refinish existing rail.
- Install new LED light fixtures.
