**LOCATION**

2900 Block of Argonne Avenue

**PROJECT INFORMATION**

City of Norfolk contractors will make major pavement repairs to Argonne Avenue. The road improvements will fix the failing base materials that have caused the asphalt to severely deteriorate. Pavement repairs on City streets promote a smooth and safe driving experience and help to support the City's multi-TRANSIT system.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

- Complete removal of asphalt.
- Repair base failures.
- Replace asphalt.

\$319,378.

**CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS/TRAFFIC**

- Streets on the 2900 block of Argonne Avenue will be closed temporarily during the pavement repair. There will be no on-street parking for the duration of the project. Access to driveways will only be permitted outside of work hours. Access to sidewalks will remain open.
- Residents are asked to place clearly marked garbage and recycling bins on the road verge, or as close to the curb as possible. Waste Management staff will walk bins to trucks to be emptied.
