

LICENSING DOGS & CATS

A license is required for every cat or dog residing in the city as soon as they reach four months of age. A current rabies certificate is required in order to obtain a license. Additionally, documentation that your animal has been spayed or neutered is required in order to receive the reduced rate.

BENEFITS

- Prevent Rabies! An animal license requires a current rabies vaccine. Make sure your pet's vaccine is up to date.
- Identify if your pet is lost.
- Make life easier at the dog park.
- It's inexpensive and easy.
