



## Chesapeake Blvd and Cromwell Drive Intersection Improvements (UPC 108797)

### Location

Chesapeake Boulevard & Cromwell Drive

### Project Benefits

This project will improve safety of the intersection by providing a new traffic signal with flashing yellow arrow signal heads.

### Scope of Work

The repairs to the bridge will include:

- New traffic signal poles and mast arms
- Retroreflective backplates and flashing yellow arrow signals
- Upgraded pedestrian accommodations
- Removal of slip lane on southwest corner of intersection
- Stormwater improvements
