This project will design and construct a new Fire-Rescue Station #11, to replace the existing station on Verdun Avenue.



SCOPE OF WORK

Construct a new Fire Rescue Station with:

- Apparatus Bay, Administrative offices, Day Room, Kitchen/Dining, Fitness Room, Storage, Decontamination, Work Shop, Canteen Area, Laundry, Berthing Area, Toilets/Showers and other Utility Spaces.
- Building size estimated at approximately 15,000 square feet.
- Work also includes site work with landscaping and parking.


