Project Benefits

This project will replace existing span of wire traffic signals with new mast arms and pedestrian accommodations.

Scope of Work

- Update obsolete infrastructure
- Installing crosswalks, sidewalks and curb ramps
- Upgraded pedestrian accommodations
- Modifying pavement markings
- Improve traffic operations

Project Schedule

- Construction Start: November 2020
- Anticipated Construction Completion: Late 2021

Project Funding

Revenue Sharing (50% State, 50% Local)
\$725,000 (\$362,000 State/\$362,000 Local)

Construction Impacts

- Lane closures and sidewalk closures will be required; at least one lane in each direction will be open at all times.
- Installation of the new signal poles and mast arms may require small detour


