Contractor: Tidewater Utility Construction, Inc.

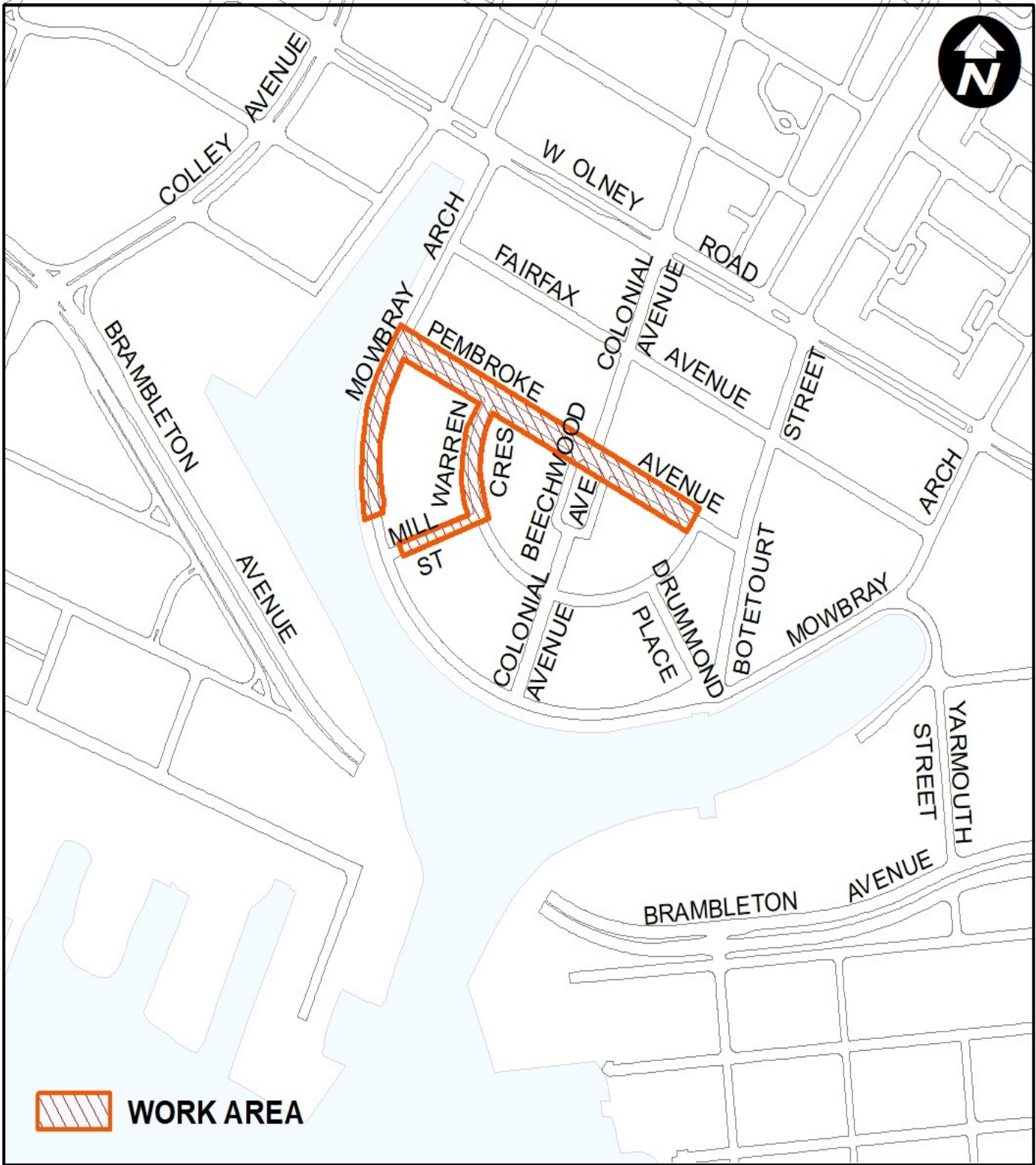
Access: Access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout construction.
