



## Brambleton Ave and Tidewater Dr Intersection Improvements (UPC 111017)

### Location

Brambleton Avenue and Tidewater Drive Intersection

### Project Benefits

This project will increase the intersection traffic capacity and reduce traffic congestion along two of the most critical arterials in Norfolk.

### Scope of Work

This project will add a second left-turn lane from southbound Tidewater Drive onto eastbound Brambleton Avenue (US 460).

### Project Status

Preparing ordinance package to accept funds

### Project Schedule

Design will begin in late 2020.

### Project Funding

\$ 645,500

### Construction Impacts

- Temporary lane closures will be required.
- Pedestrian detours will provide safe passage for pedestrians through the intersection.

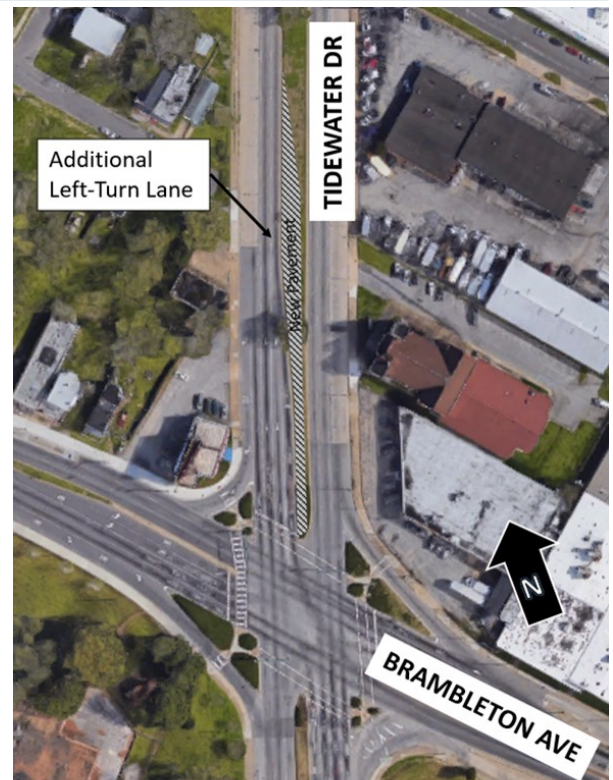
