The Department of Utilities will be constructing a new sanitary sewer pump station located at 526 Fenchurch Road. The pump station will support the new homes and businesses planned near the Downtown Transit Center. Capable of moving nearly 800,000 gallons a day of domestic and business wastewater to the Hampton Roads Sanitation District (HRSD) facilities for appropriate treatment, the pump station will play a vital role in public health and clean waterways.
