PROJECT INFORMATION

This project will rehabilitate the 26th Street Bridge to help extend the service life of the bridge.

SCOPE OF WORK

The project will include repair of cracks, delaminations and spalls in the concrete deck, curbs, sidewalks, edge beams, underside of deck, abutments and bent caps, deck sealing, waterproofing of concrete structural components, installation of neoprene deck expansion joints and pavement line markings.

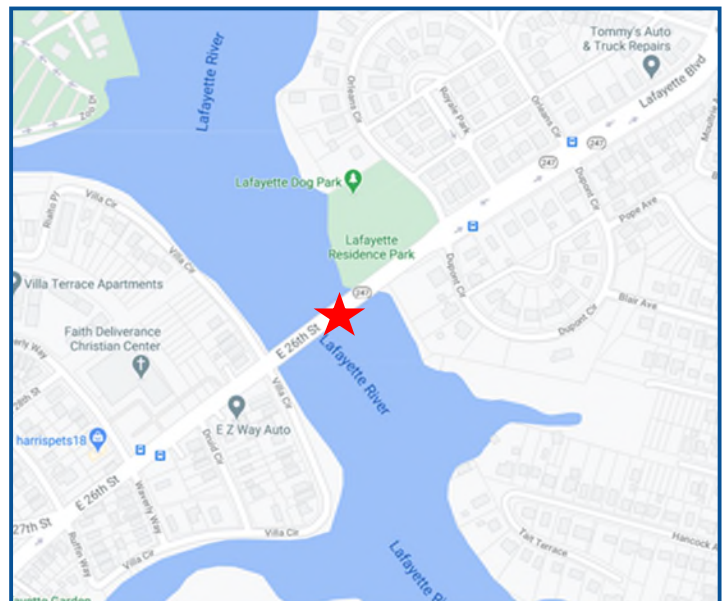
