PROJECT INFORMATION

The project will upgrade the storm drainage infrastructure in a residential neighborhood. The upgrades will improve the collection, movement, and discharge of stormwater runoff to reduce flooding.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Install new storm drainage conveyance system consisting of pipes and structures
- Remove/replace portions of curb and gutter, and sidewalk
- Asphalt mill and overlay & pavement patch
