ADOPTION TO-GO BAGS

Helpful reminder:

Please do not use any of the following items which may present a danger to the animals:

- Expired food products
- Toxic glue or materials
- Glitter
- Items that may become loose, which an animal may swallow, including bells, trinkets, beads, etc.
- String that may fray or be swallowed

Supplies

- Brown paper lunch bags
- Colored pencils or crayons
- Your imagination!

Instructions

1. Make these as colorful and fun as you would like.
2. Use colored markers, pens, pencils, stickers or crayons.
3. Write the word "NAME" with a line after it, (Name: _____) so we may fill in the animal's name.
4. Draw any animal of your choice, a cartoon or whatever creative art you can dream up.
5. Fill with anything a new adopter might need: treats, poop baggies, or even some of the exciting activities below!



SOCK FISH CAT TOYS

Supplies

- Old socks
- Catnip
- Scissors
- Non-toxic markers

Instructions

1. Roll an 8 1/2-by-11-inch piece of paper into a cone for a funnel, secure with tape.
2. Insert funnel into sock and fill halfway with catnip.
3. Knot the sock just above filling.
4. Using a non-toxic marker, give it some eyes, a mouth, and some fun details!



CATNIP FELT FISH

Supplies

- Pencil & Paper
- Felt
- Pins
- Pinking shears
- Cotton batting or wool scraps
- Piece of paper
- Catnip
- Needle and thread
- Upholstery needle and thin sturdy twine (for hanging)

Instructions

1. Ask a parent or guardian first to ask for help since you will be using sharp objects.
2. Draw and cut out fish shape.
3. A $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance needs to be added to the fish shape.
4. Trace the fish shape onto two layers of fabric. Cut out shapes.
5. Pin right sides together.
6. Sew seam, and leave 1 1/2-inch opening for filling.
7. Trim seams with pinking shears.
8. Turn right side out. Press seams flat.
9. Stuff with cotton batting or wool scraps until firm.
10. Shape a piece of paper into a funnel.
11. Use the funnel to add 1 to 2 tablespoons of dried catnip or to fill the whole toy with catnip.
12. Hand-stitch opening securely closed.



TURTLE SHAPED CAT TREAT DISPENSER

Supplies

- Cardboard egg carton
- Nontoxic liquid glue
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Binder clips
- Decorating materials

Instructions

1. Ask a parent or guardian first to ask for help since you will be using sharp objects.
2. Cut an egg cup from the carton to serve as the shell of the turtle.
3. Place the cup adjacent to the spacer bump on the reverse side of the top of the carton.
4. Trace around the perimeter to outline the contour of the spacer. This will form the head of the turtle, as well as a base to keep the food inside the shell.
5. Cut the lid following the outline you've made.
6. Apply glue around the edge of the egg cup.
7. Clamp the two pieces together using the binder clips.
8. Let the glue set.
9. Decorate your turtle.

FLEECE BRAIDED TOYS

Supplies

- Fleece
- Fabric scissors
- Yard stick

Instructions

1. Ask a parent or guardian first to ask for help since you will be using sharp objects.
2. Using yard stick cut three to six strips of fleece.
3. Gather strips of fleece and tie large knot at one end.
4. Separate fleece strips into three sections then braid.
 - a. Be sure to leave enough fleece to tie a knot at the end.

HIDE-AND-SEEK BOX

Supplies

- Recycled cardboard box (no larger than 24"x24")
- Tape
- Utility Knife
- Plastic cat toy balls
- Hot Glue Gun
- Hot Glue Sticks

Instructions

1. Ask a parent or guardian first to ask for help since you will be using sharp objects.
2. Cut out small openings all over box.
3. Tape together all seams of the box.
4. Place the toy balls inside.
5. Decorate! The more color the better!



DOGGIE COOKIES

Supplies


- 2/3 cup pumpkin puree
- 1/4 cup peanut butter (that does not contain xylitol)
- 2 large eggs
- 2 1/2 - 3 cups of flour
- Cookie cutter

Instructions


1. Ask a parent or guardian first to ask for help since you will be using sharp objects & the oven.
2. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
3. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper or a silicone baking mat; set aside.
4. In a large bowl, beat pumpkin puree, peanut butter and eggs on until well combined, about 1-2 minutes.
5. Gradually add 2 1/2 cups flour at low speed, beating just until incorporated.
6. Add an additional 1/4 cup flour at a time just until the dough is no longer sticky.
7. Working on a lightly floured surface, knead the dough until it comes together.
8. Using a rolling pin, roll the dough to 1/4-inch thickness.
9. Using cookie cutters, cut out desired shapes and place onto the prepared baking sheet.
10. Place into oven and bake until the edges are golden brown, about 20-25 minutes.
11. Let cool completely, refrigerate, and deliver within 24 hours of making.
