

Illegal Sign Removal Training & Authorization

City Code Section 42-10 provides for the removal of illegal signs.

Subsection (e) ...Additionally, a citizen designated by the Director of Public Works, who has [received] training provided by the Director, may be authorized by the Director to remove signs, placards or notices placed in the right-of-way or on city property.

What are Illegal Signs?

Illegal signs are all non-City owned signs placed within the right of way (ROW) without permission. The ROW includes streets, the area between curb and sidewalk, and medians. The ROW contains utility poles, signal poles, and trees. These areas are often used to place or hang illegal signs.

Why Remove Illegal Signs?

- Sight obstructions
- Safety hazards
- Eye sores
- Litter

How to Remove Illegal Signs?

- Safely
- Obey traffic laws
- Do not engage

Do Not:

- Damage property
- Remove at night
- Pull staples or other devices from signs
- Attempt to remove signs mounted high
- Place stickers on signs; remove them

Do Not Remove:

- Political and/or Campaign signs
- Civic League meeting or notice signs
- Open House signs (on the day of)
- Please report these signs, large signs, and/or those mounted high to Right of Way
