**AFFIDAVIT: FARM**

I have applied to the business license division of the Commissioner of the Revenue's office and have been informed that this type of business activity is not required to purchase a license, per State Code Sec. 58.1-3719 (4) – *Any license tax imposed on peddlers or itinerant merchants or on a peddler at wholesale shall not apply to a farmer or producer of agricultural products who sell only the farm or agricultural products produced by him*).

I further understand that the penalties involved for making a false statement is a Class 1 misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine of not more than \$2,500 and/or confinement in jail for no more than 12 months (City Codes 24-25.3).

This affidavit is valid for applicant only during the current business year and will expire December 31<sup>st</sup>.
