K. Committee Reports: Administration and Planning & Investment Management

1. Administration and Planning Committee - no meeting
2. Investment Management Committee -
 - a. Executed agreement with North Pier to begin search process for Outsourced Chief Investment Officer (OCIO)
 - i. Meeting to be held on November 9, 2021, at 1:00 p.m.
 - b. Executed revised AndCo consulting services agreement
 - c. As of July 1, 2019, Total Plan Actuarial Liability (AL) is \$1.398 billion, and the Actuarial Value of Assets (AVA) is \$1.097 billion for an Actuarial funded ratio (AVA/AL) of 79%. Using the Market Value of Assets (MVA), the Market Funded Ratio (MVA/AL) was approximately 99% in August 2021 and 96% in September 2021
 - d. Relevant Asset Allocation
 - i. Global Equities decreased by 0.65%
 - ii. Fixed Income increased by 0.27%
 - iii. Real Estate increased by 0.20%
 - iv. MLP's increased by 0.19%
 - e. Total Fund Composite decreased by 0.27%
 - f. Total Fund Policy Index decreased by 0.66%

L. Other / Old Business

1. Virginia Retirement System (VRS)
 - a. Effective January 1, 2022, all City employees newly hired and rehired will be participating member of the VRS
 - b. All current, active Norfolk Employees' Retirement System members will have a window of opportunity (January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022) to elect to terminate their NERS membership and become participating members in VRS or to remain a NERS participant. This is an irrevocable retirement plan election.
 - c. NERS vs VRS educational sessions conducted through Microsoft Teams

- i. Approximately 600 employees have attended an educational session, which provides an overview and a comparison between NERS and VRS. At the end of each session there is a Question and Answer session with the members.
 - ii. Presentations have been made available on the staff intranet
 - iii. Individual consultations have been made available

 - a. Distribution amount of \$1,410,271.70 received on October 5, 2021
 - b. Distribution amount of \$230,841.43 received on October 22, 2021

M. New Business/Other

1. NERS received the award for Outstanding Achievement in Popular Annual Financial Reporting from the Government Finance Officers' Association (GFOA). This was the first time NERS had prepared and submitted a Popular Annual Financial Report (PAFR), and to receive the award for our first submission puts us in an elite group. The PAFR is a best practice designed to give our stakeholders an easy-to-understand overview of the NERS' financial position.
