



# Ocean View Avenue Comprehensive Transportation Study

## Location

Ocean View Avenue from Willoughby Spit to East Beach (intersection of Shore Dr. and Pretty Lake Ave).

## Project Benefits

This project advances Norfolk’s Multimodal Transportation Master Plan, the 2015 Strategic Bicycle & Pedestrian Plan, and Vision Zero by promoting safe travel options for all modes, improving multimodal connectivity, and providing traffic calming benefits.

## Scope of Work

This study takes a comprehensive look at how to improve the safety and accessibility of bicycles, pedestrians, and vehicles along the Ocean View Avenue corridor with particular focus on:

- Completing gaps in the bicycle network
- Evaluating the feasibility of accommodating golf cart travel
- Improving pedestrian crossings and beach access
- Addressing speeding

## Project Status

Comprehensive study completed. Included a traffic study, conceptual design development, and public engagement.
