Location

Hampton Boulevard between Woodview Avenue and Rogers Avenue.

Project Benefits

This project will advance Norfolk Complete Streets initiative and Vision Zero resolution by promoting safe access for all pedestrians, bicyclist, motorists and transit users of all ages and abilities in the community and providing traffic calming benefits.

Scope of Work

- Install median barriers at the unsignalized intersections to prevent left turns from side streets or driveways onto Hampton Boulevard.
- A companion project will install pedestrian signals at Glendale Avenue and Beechwood Avenue.

Project Status

- Design concept completed.
- Public outreach underway.

Project Schedule

- Anticipated final design start: Spring 2022
- Anticipated construction start: Summer 2022
- Anticipated construction completion: Fall 2022


