

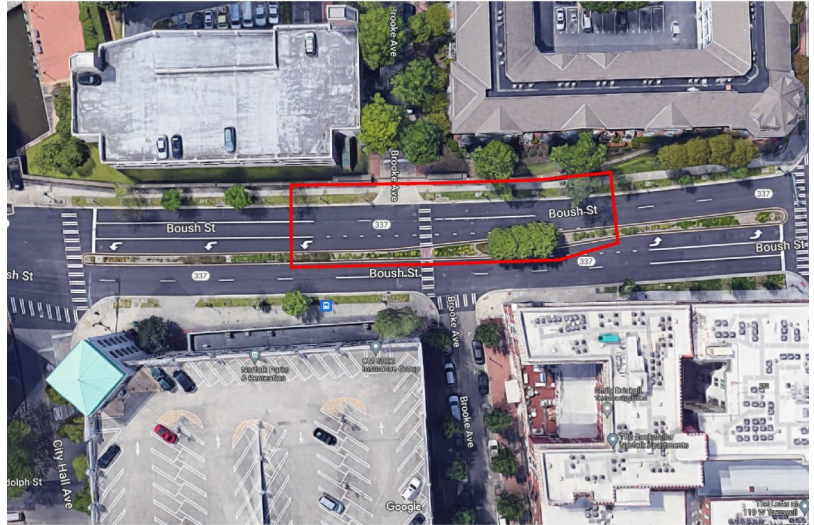
BOUSH ST AND BROOKE AVE PEDESTRIAN CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS

LOCATION

Boush St between W. City Hall Ave and Brooke Ave

PROJECT INFORMATION

The project will improve safety for pedestrian's crossing Boush St at Brooke Ave, by enlarging the median on Boush St. The affected street section is highlighted on the attached location sketch. Once the median work is completed, the next phase of the project includes the installation of pedestrian activated Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB). RRFB's help provide highlighted awareness to motorists that pedestrians are about to cross Boush St.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS/TRAFFIC

- Work will be performed during the week day between the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.
- Single lane closures are anticipated in each direction along Boush St. during construction.
- Motorists should expect alternating lane closures, intermittent traffic stoppages and are encouraged to take alternate routes, such as Saint Paul's Blvd, to avoid construction.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
- Trash and recycling services will continue as normal.
