

- I. **Recommendation:** Adopt Ordinance
- II. **Applicant:** Norfolk Sheriff's Office
- III. **Description:**  
This agenda item is an ordinance to permit use of funds from the United States Capitol Police for the fiscal year 2023 to the Norfolk Sheriff's Office appropriating and authorizing the expenditure of funds in the amount of Sixty-eight thousand dollars (\$68,000.00) when received to pay certain deputy sheriffs as independent contractors for providing security support.
- IV. **Analysis:**  
The United States Capitol Police for fiscal year 2023 is making available funding to pay for certain deputies to provide security support to a U.S. Congresswoman residing in the City of Norfolk. The Norfolk Sheriff's Office is a subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, independent of the city of Norfolk, Virginia, and whose independent contractors and employees are not contractors of the City of Norfolk.

## Ordinance No.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FY2023 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE (NO. 48,751) SO AS TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE AND AUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS UP TO THE SUM OF \$68,000.00 FROM THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL POLICE TO ALLOW THE SHERIFF TO PAY CERTAIN DEPUTY SHERIFFS AS INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS FOR PROVIDING SECURITY SUPPORT TO A U.S. CONGRESSWOMAN RESIDING IN THE CITY OF NORFOLK.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norfolk:

Section 1:- That the FY2023 annual appropriations ordinance (No. 48,751) is amended and reordained so as to add Section 14 subparagraph (xxx) in its entirety to read as follows:

(xxx) That, if and when made available from the United States Capitol Police, the sum of up to sixty eight thousand dollars (\$68,000.00) is hereby appropriated and authorized for expenditure to allow the Sheriff to pay certain Deputy Sheriffs as independent contractors for providing security support to a U.S. Congresswoman residing in the City of Norfolk. The Norfolk Sheriff's Office is a subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, independent of the City of Norfolk, Virginia, and whose independent contractors and employees are not contractors or employees of the City.

Section 2:- That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its adoption.
