St. Paul's Transformation Area

Project Benefits

This project will create new roadway infrastructure in the St. Paul's Transformation Area. The project will extend Freemason Street to Tidewater Drive and construct new local streets in Tidewater Gardens. The project also includes a new traffic signal at Tidewater Drive and Freemason Street and a bridge structure along Freemason over the proposed blue greenway park. Additional work will include stormwater improvements, wide sidewalks, dedicated bike facilities. This project will be combined with Department of Public Utilities' project providing upgraded sanitary sewer and water services to the area.

- 7,000 feet of new roadway
- New traffic signal
- New bridge
- Wide sidewalks and pedestrian accommodations
- Shared use path
